ARCADIA APPOINTS PAUL CRANMER AS DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC WORKS SERVICES

October 18, 2021 – Arcadia City Manager Dominic Lazzaretto has appointed Deputy Public Works Director Paul Cranmer to the position of Director of Public Works Services. He will succeed Tom Tait who announced his retirement in October 2021.

He holds a bachelor's degree in Environmental Sciences from Cal Poly San Luis Obispo. Paul and his wife have a young daughter and enjoy spending time traveling and playing sports.

"I am honored to be the City's next Director of Public Works Services," said Deputy Director Cranmer. "I appreciate the support and confidence of the City Manager and City Council, and look forward to serving as Director alongside a highly motivated and dedicated staff."
