Achieving Energy Efficiency Through Small Contractor Participation

Southern California Regional Energy Network's (SoCalREN) Workforce Education and Training Program provides training, tools, and opportunities for participants to pursue careers and contract opportunities in energy efficiency. SoCalREN was established by the California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC) in 2012 and serves the areas covered by both Southern California Edison (SCE) and SoCalGas.
