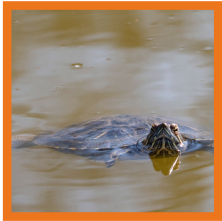


MAMMALS OF ARCADIA

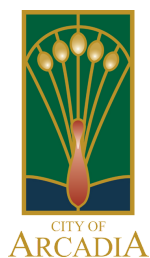


BIRDS OF ARCADIA
